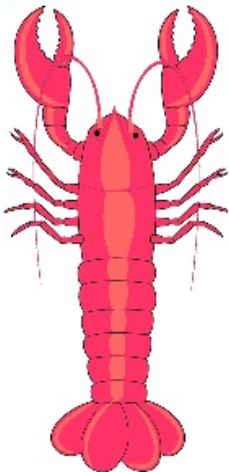

IMPORTANT SHIPYARD ACCESS INFORMATION

Due to increased security procedures at the Shipyard, we must enforce the following rules in order for all of our chapter members, family and guests to have access to the Shipyard. These are:

1. We must have a **full** list (**first & last names**) of all attendees **NTL 28 July 2017**. Names of all guests must be listed on a separate sheet. Late additions will be handled on a case by case basis.
2. All attendees must identify themselves as going to the Clambake to the guard at the gate and show a valid military ID, or state driver's license and/or other forms of picture ID.
