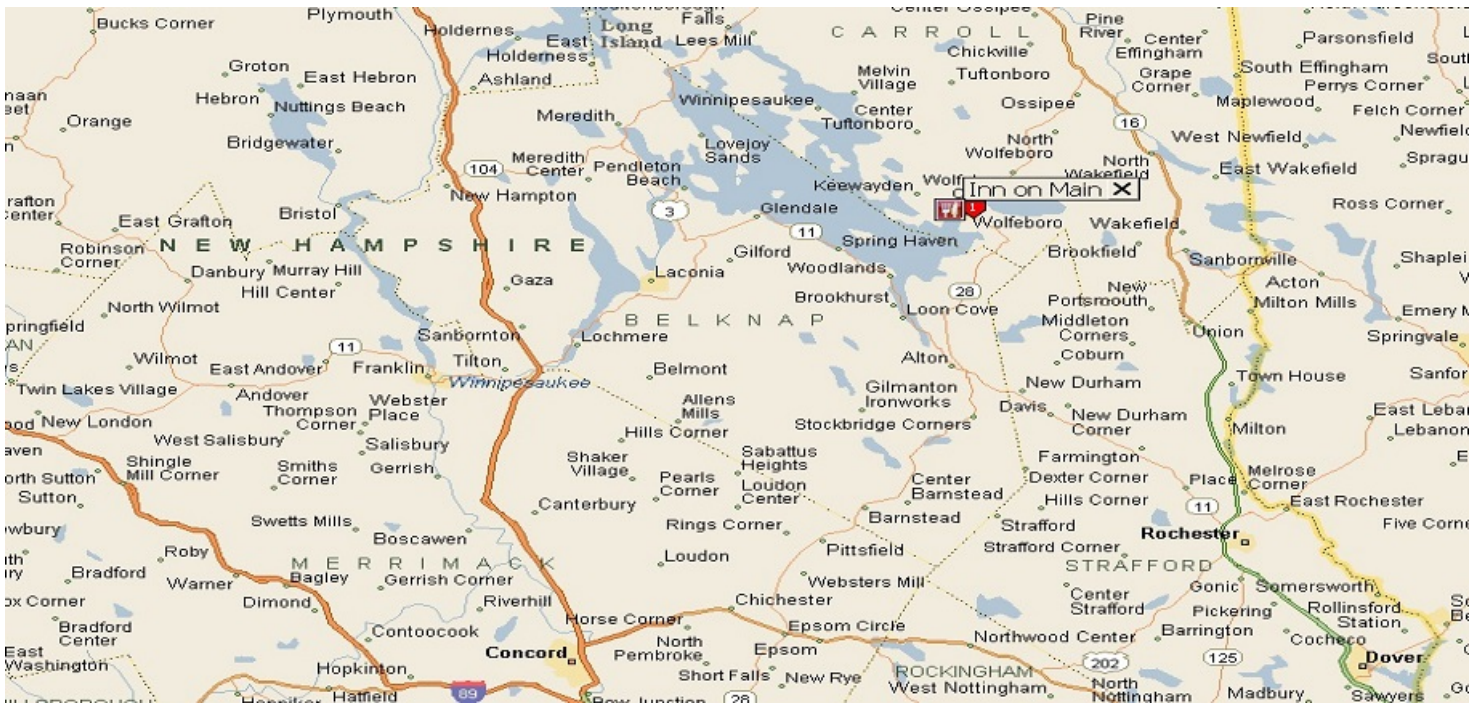

Wright Museum of World War II 77 Center Street, Wolfeboro, NH

The Wright Museum is an homage to everything related to the second World War. Exhibits, including the new Time Tunnel display, focus tightly on the years 1939 to 1945.

Housed in two connecting buildings, the museum is divided into domestic life and war. A period plane hangs from the ceiling of the military wing above a working Sherman tank. All the vehicles, from a half track to vintage ambulance, are all in working order and used in local parades.

The domestic section includes a number of family tableaux. Visitors lean against the railing, pointing out familiar items from their own lives. The building is chock full of tools, toys, posters, appliances and nostalgic items from the war years. Big bands and military tunes play gently in the background. A 10-minute video, narrated in part by TV-anchorman Tom Brokaw, orients new visitors.
