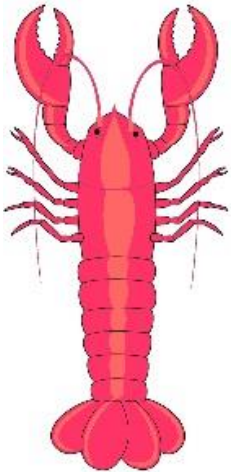
IMPORTANT SHIPYARD ACCESS INFORMATION

Due to increased security procedures at the Shipyard, we must enforce the following rules in order for all of our chapter members, family and guests to have access to the Shipyard. These are:

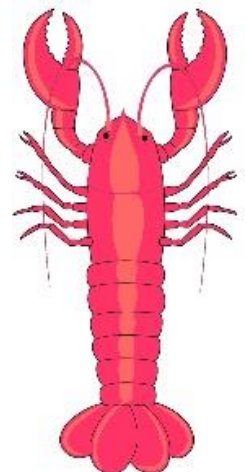

2. All attendees must identify themselves as going to the Lobsterbake to the guard at the gate and show a valid military ID, or state driver's license and/or other forms of picture ID.
