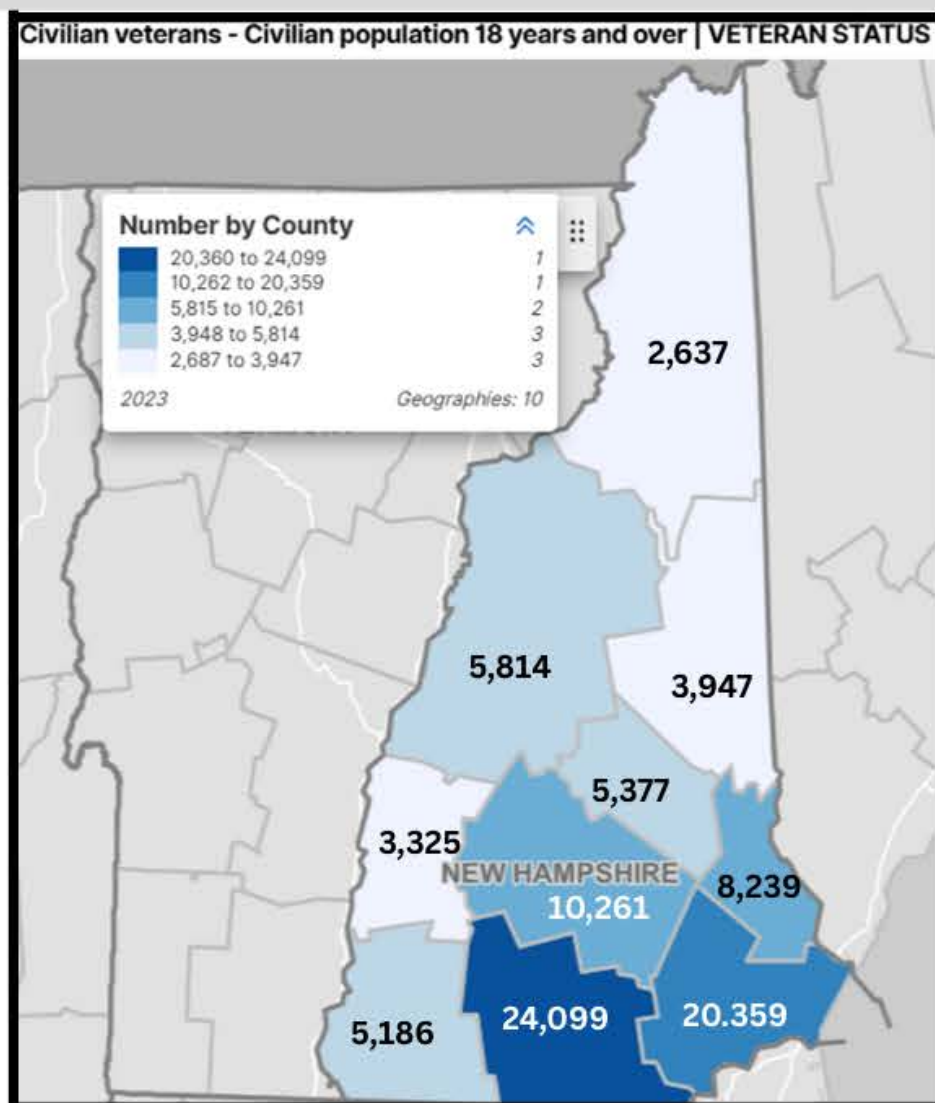


New Hampshire Veteran Resources



85,749 Veterans live in NH

Period of Service		Age Distribution	
World War II	0.7%	75 years and over	30.8%
Korean War	3.0%	65 to 74 years	21.7%
Vietnam War	34.6%	55 to 64 years	22.2%
Gulf War I (Persian Gulf)	21.0%	35 to 54 years	19.5%
Gulf War II (Iraq, Afghanistan)	21.8%	18 to 34 years	5.8%

Health

46,062 Veterans are enrolled in the VA Healthcare system

32,328 Veterans are receiving disability compensation

Nationally (2024), 17.6 Veteran suicides a day
after accounting for age differences, NH Veteran suicide rate was not significantly different than national Veteran suicide rate but was significantly higher than national general population.

A Veteran Suicide reported in NH about every ~2 weeks

Housing Stability

Approximately 80% own their own homes

At any given time about 150 Veterans reported as homeless in NH

173 Veterans permanently housed in 2024 in NH

84.5% of NH Veterans experiencing homelessness report a disabling condition

Economic wellbeing

29% of Veterans earn between \$100-199K

31% of Veterans earn between \$50-99K

31% of Veterans earn less than \$50,000 a year

Veterans earn about 7% less than NH median income

~5% of NH Veterans live at/below the poverty level

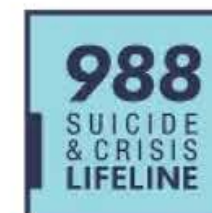
